

YOUNG COMMONERS TRAILER TRAINING GRANT

Criteria for Eligibility

Applicants must be:

- under the age of 36
- paying marking fees in their own right.
- turning out a minimum of three animals on to the Forest.
- a fully paid up member of the CDA

Application Process

- 1. Young Commoner must successfully book, pay for and complete the training and test.
- 2. Young Commoner must complete the grant application form and return it together with a copy of their receipt and evidence confirming that they have passed their trailer test.
- 3. The Young Commoners' Committee will review the application at the next meeting and assess it against the above criteria
- 4. Assuming the applicant is successful the applicant will be provided with a cheque to cover the cost of the training up to a limit of £700 per person

Terms and Conditions

- The grant will be capped at a maximum of £700 per person.
- The grant will only cover the cost of the training and not the test.
- The applicant must have been responsible for paying for their training in the same year as their application is received by the Young Commoners Committee.
- The Young Commoners' Committee reserve the right to consider each application on its own merits and determine as they feel appropriate in light of the scheme's intentions.
- The applicant must provide all of the information requested on the form and subsequently by the Committee.
- The applicant must be under the age of 36 on the day that they submit their grant application.
- The applicant must be a fully paid up member of the New Forest Commoners Defence Association (CDA).
- The Applicant must be paying marking fees in their own right.
- The applicant must be turning out a minimum of three animals on to the Forest.
