TEN things Shared Forest Business group members agree to do:

All members agree to:

1. Include safe driving on Forest roads in induction courses
2. Give out/display 'Advice for New Forest Drivers' leaflet to staff members and on their company website for visitors to see
3. Give out Emergency Hotline cards to staff members and as many connected people as possible. Display them to customers in reception areas
4. Allow extra time to drivers who use the unfenced roads across the Forest during their working day
5. Respond promptly and openly to direct feedback related to New Forest driving, including follow-up with the driver concerned
6. Display Shared Forest Business stickers on company vehicles

Members also try to:

7. Display Shared Forest road safety posters on company premises
8. Invite staff members to display 'I go slow for ponies' stickers in their personal vehicles
9. Join Shared Forest initiatives to spread the word about safe driving on New Forest roads
10. Cascade Shared Forest's quarterly driving advice to staff: to include updates on the project and seasonal driving advice

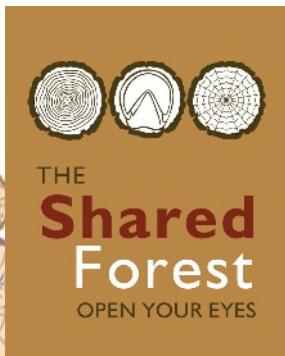
