The Commoners Defence Association opposed the issuing of licenses for food / drink vans in the car parks, our stance has not changed, we are still against this policy

The licenses are due for renewal but consideration must be given to the Forestry England's pledge to move where appropriate, the vans into the enclosures, fencing the remaining off from the stock.

This undertaking by FE has not happened. We therefore request that the Verderers withhold their consent, if it's going to be given, until these conditions are met.
